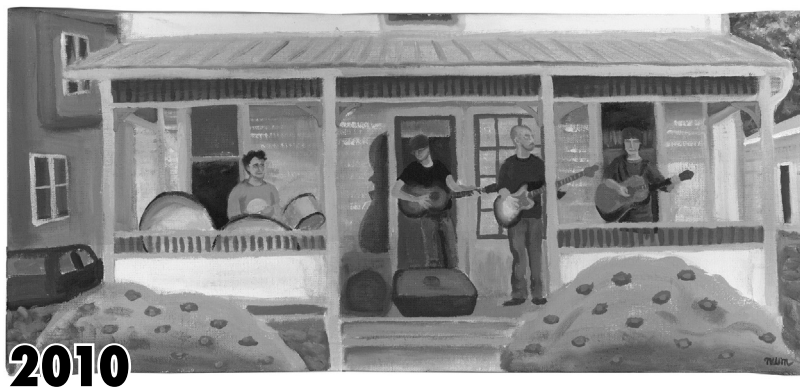
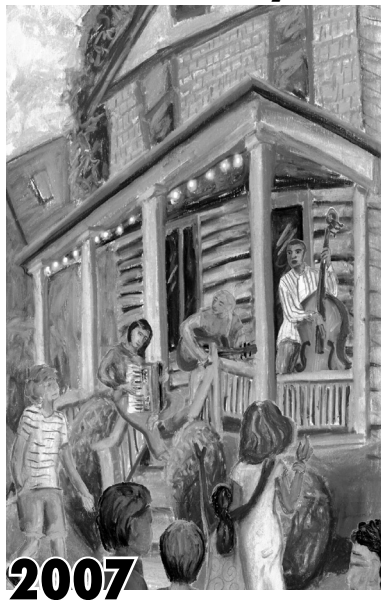
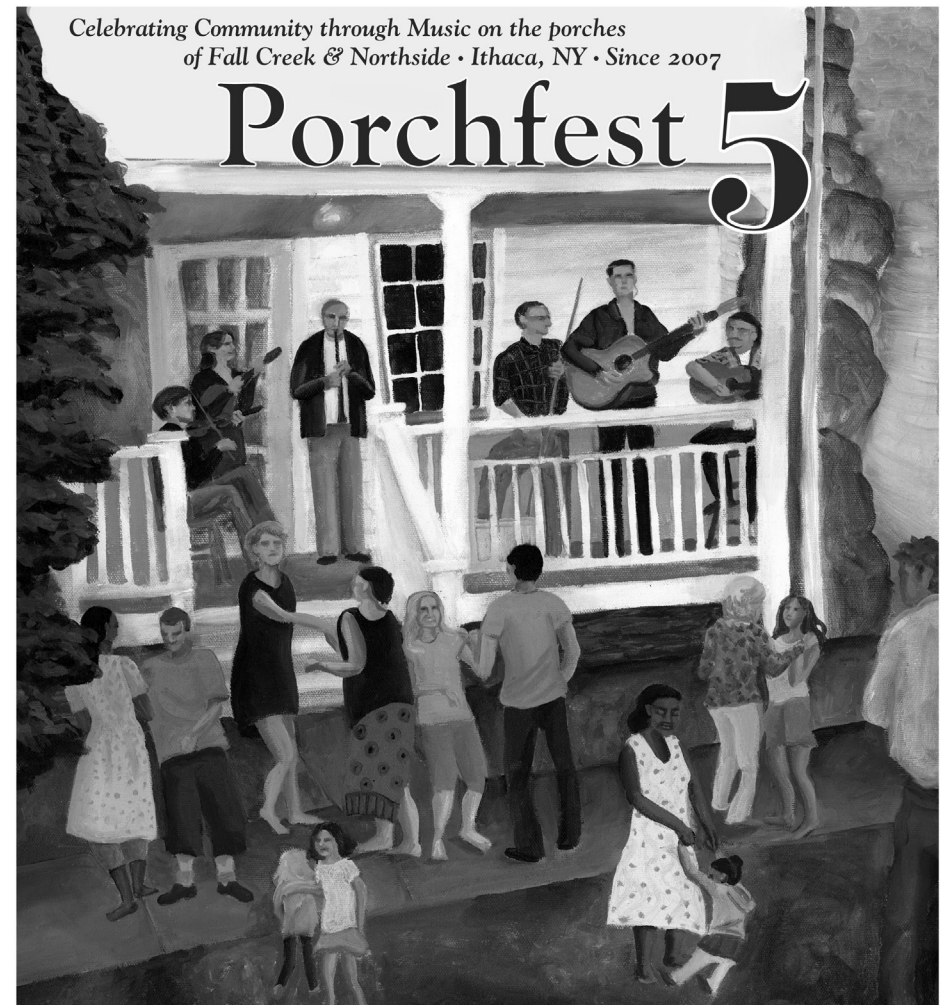

The 18 Strings Of Luv [3] (Ken Zeserson, Jan Nigro and John Simon) sing great songs of the 60's Beatles, Motown etc.

Air War [3] is a new Indie electro dub step performer. His tunes will get inside your head and stay there. And he's not even 14!

Alex Specker Trio featuring Wayne Gottlieb [1] play a mix of vintage swing jazz and blues.

Babypony [2] is super strong rock songs.

BadHand [1] is a one-man band.

Bert Salmirs, piano [3], plays selections from the Great American Songbook.

Black is Green [3] (Jake Roberts and Arly Kamholtz) weaves a sound that is a moody, wandering journey into the subconscious.

The Black Walnut Band [1] plays original country soul music and features veteran musicians of the local music scene.

Bronwen Exter [1] returned from a 10-year exile in NYC with new songs about tragic eccentrics, cheap suffering & coming home.

The Buffalo Horns of Ithaca [3] play traditional hunting tunes, jazzy compositions, and arrangements of standard classical fare.

Burns And Kristy [3] are singer/songwriters Terry Burns and Ron Kristy joined by Janet Cottraccia and Peter Wetherbee.

Chattering Walnut [1] is Max, a second grader who likes to sing and play guitar.

Cielle [3] is a bluesy original singer songwriter with a hauntingly beautiful voice.

CORNUCOPIA [1] is a trio of keyboard, violin, and bassoon.

Crush [1] is loud on the corner! Drums and keys! Covers and originals! Dance-ready!

Djug Django [3] is Ithaca's premier Gypsy/Jazz/Swing/Country/Blues band.

Deixa Sambar [3], Ithaca's own samba group, plays Brazil's national music. ithacasamba.com

Dylan's Desire [2] is a loose group of performers from NY & NJ gathering to perform the classic 1975 Bob Dylan album "Desire"

The Eclectics [2] is Jan Nigro, Ken Zeserson, Alex Specker and Joe Bruno playing various genres: blues, jazz, rock, pop, folk.

El Caminos [1] is Alt Country, Cowpunk, Rockabilly, or whatever our mood is at the time. Fun and boot-stompin'!

El Rumbon [2] is an 8-piece salsa band that plays dance music from Puerto Rico, Cuba, Columbia and beyond.

Ella, Miles and Friends [2] is a jazz group that features Ithaca High Schoolers Ella Sarachan singing and Miles Allen on sax.

Ephemera [1] is an acapella improv group with haunting harmonies that create magical, musical mayhem.

The Experimenters [3] is experimental improvisations from a 7-year-old drummer and his dad (Silas and Nate Richardson).

The Fall Creek Bluegrass Partners [3] entertain you with bluegrass favorites on banjo, guitar, mandolin, dobro, bass, fiddle.

The Fall Creek Praise Band [3] is acoustic praise and worship music performed by a group of Cornell students.

Fall Crikkers Barn Dance [2] is swinging tunes, singing squares, waltzes and more with Vikki A, Dave D & Friends. Y'all come!

The Fly Rods [3] take sonic inspiration from rock and roll bands like Crazy Horse, CCR, Ramones, Velvet Underground and others.

Geezer [2] is the (anti)band... they lay down grooves that make you shake your booty down to the barrelhouse...

The Geronimo Line [2] plays originals influenced by Spaghetti Western, grunge, reggae, African grooves and Latin ballads.

Glass Half Full [3] is an acoustic duo featuring Tom Farrell and Liza Burger.

GoGone [2] is original roots, rock, blues, capturing far away places, other times and the always changing human condition.

Gorges Tones [2] is an energetic women's acappella group that will leave you blown away. Not your mother's acappella group!

Gospel Hymn Sing [3] is Edna Brown and Susan Lytle doing mostly a cappella gospel and hymns in harmony. Sing along!

The Grady Girls [2] is toe tapping, heart lifting Irish tunes played by a group of sisters and cousins.

The Gunpoets [3] bring their revolutionary new school rap sound to the world with a passion and energy rarely seen.

Hanging Out the Wash [3] plays traditional Celtic, French Canadian and Southern Old-Time fiddle music.

The Hilltoppers [3] are acoustic bluegrass/roots music.

The Hot Dogs [2] are an acoustic duo consisting of Seadog Mickey on lead guitar and Dogberry on rhythm guitar.

Hubcap [1] is Electric Indie Power Pop.

Ironic [1] is originals and some covers "our way" joined by our kids.

Ithaca Area Storytellers [1] will share stories for all ages.

Ithaca Gay Men's Chorus [2] runs the gamut of music for men's voices and four-part harmony.

Ithaca's Southern Old Time Jam [1] is the weekly Old Time Jam, hosted by Laura Taylor.

i venti dementi [1] is a light-hearted harmoniemusik-inspired chamber group with clarinets, horns and bassoons.

Jan Nigro Trio [2] is Lisa Frank, Alice Saltonstall and Jan Nigro singing Jan's original songs.

The JazzHappensBand [1] specializes in traditional Dixieland music.

Jen Cork [3] is soulful, original folk/jazz/blues.

The K.T.s [1]: Kids playing swing, blues, and waltz tunes--come to listen, to dance, and/or play our last tune with us (Blues in C)!

KlezEpic [1] is a youth Klezmer band, led by Max Buckholtz, playing traditional Klezmer and Moldavian Jewish and Gypsy music.

The Lucky Pluckers [2] perform old timey tunes with their own unique twist, and newer songs with old timey flavor.

Mad Goat [3] is an old-time fiddle band playing songs and tunes in the Southern style. Bring your clogging shoes.

Maplewood Jazz Team [3] is Swing and Bossa Nova Standards and More.

Moonfish Ocean [2] is progressive acoustic rock and folk.

Mosaic Foundation [3] is a Roots Reggae band.

Nate & Kate [3] deliver a mix of heartfelt modern folk songs, humor, & juggling that add up to a unique & dynamic show.

New Field Border [1] is a 6-piece song & dance band. Original acoustic-electric guitar-piano roots rock.

Nina Svatovic [1] is a singer songwriter whose music has been described as acoustic soul with folk roots.

Not From Wisconsin [3] is an alt-country, indie-rock inspired band.

The Origin Brass [1] is a brass band playing a mixture of jazz & funk heavily influenced by the New Orleans street band tradition.

The Pearly Snaps [3] is hot old-time music with Rosie Newton & Stephanie Jenkins.

Polly & Travis [2] is a fresh acoustic duo with an authentically uplifting vibe.

Professor Tuesday's Jazz Quartet [1] brings mainstream Tuesday Jazz to Sunday.

The Purple Valley [3] play blues, swing, and rock and roll to dance or tap your feet to, with vocal harmonies to keep you smiling.

Richie Stearns & the Evil City String Band [1] is old time Appalachian string band music.

Rosie Rocca Trio [1] is Rosie (formerly of The Stilletos) w/ Ceili Murphy & Casey Georgi....a team of generational mix and power.

Roy Hurd's [2] music is a breath of fresh mountain air. Roy will be performing with his daughter, Meadow Merry.

The Seneca Street Recorder Ensemble [1] play a wide range of appealing Renaissance, Celtic and Contemporary music.

Shimmer Lake [2] is Amy Davis & Laura Peters and features radiant vocal clarity, shimmering harmonies and two guitars.

Shuhan Brothers and Friends [1] are brothers Max and Sam and their talented musician friends.

Sing-along at the Ithaca Friends Meetinghouse [2] is a very informal sing-fest led by Susan Wolfe. Come and join in.

Small Kings [2] are Post-pop Funk-daddy Rockers on Bluegrass.

Spacetrain [2] is Melodic Front Porch Indie Rock.

Squirrelroc [2] is 4 dads with widely varying music tastes performing a tasty mix of cover songs from the '70s to '90s, with flair.

State & Plain [2] write pop songs that channel the melodies of the Beach Boys through the Violent Femmes plus Yo La Tengo.

Sum Dude [2] is Ross Feldman, Joey Arcuri, and Bruce Korreich. Original Folk with a Rocky Blues thing that winds through it.

The Tarps [2]: "We are a cover band for classic rock, thus we are the tarps."

Technicolor Trailer Park [1] is a duo that performs "in your face Folk."

Teen Karaoke at the Ithaca Friends Meetinghouse [1] is solos, duets and group numbers by talented youth.

Tenzin Chopak & Eric Ott [2] is originals & covers w/ acoustic guitar, upright bass, banjo & singing. Alt country, folk & big love.

That Old Lovelight [1]: Singer/songwriter. Wife/husband. Pianica/Nashville-tuned guitar. They sing about matters of the heart.

Timothy Weber [1] sings the kinds of songs 40-year-old ex-hippies like.

Tom Mank and Sera Smolen [2] are modern folk blues improvisation, with Mank, a singer-songwriter & Smolen, cellist.

Tribacco [3] is from Italy! Rock punk jazz.

Tru Bleu [3] is an acoustic blues/rock trio giving you original tunes with harmonies and soul.

Tubax [3] is from Italy! Prog rock electronica.

Ukulelese as a Second Language [3] is an impromptu workshop with performances on ukuleles with Auntie Emo & Friends.

Uniit Carruyo [2]- her gentle voice and guitar will massage your ears and tune your heart to its rhythm.

Unity Studio [2] is quickly becoming one of Ithaca's hubs for new, original, up and coming Hip-Hop artists.

Valerie Anne [1] is a singer/songwriter w/ a soulful voice & insightful lyrics.

Waiting for Edna [2] is Marek Przewdziecki, Dave Wentzel and Edna Brown playing eclectic americana music.

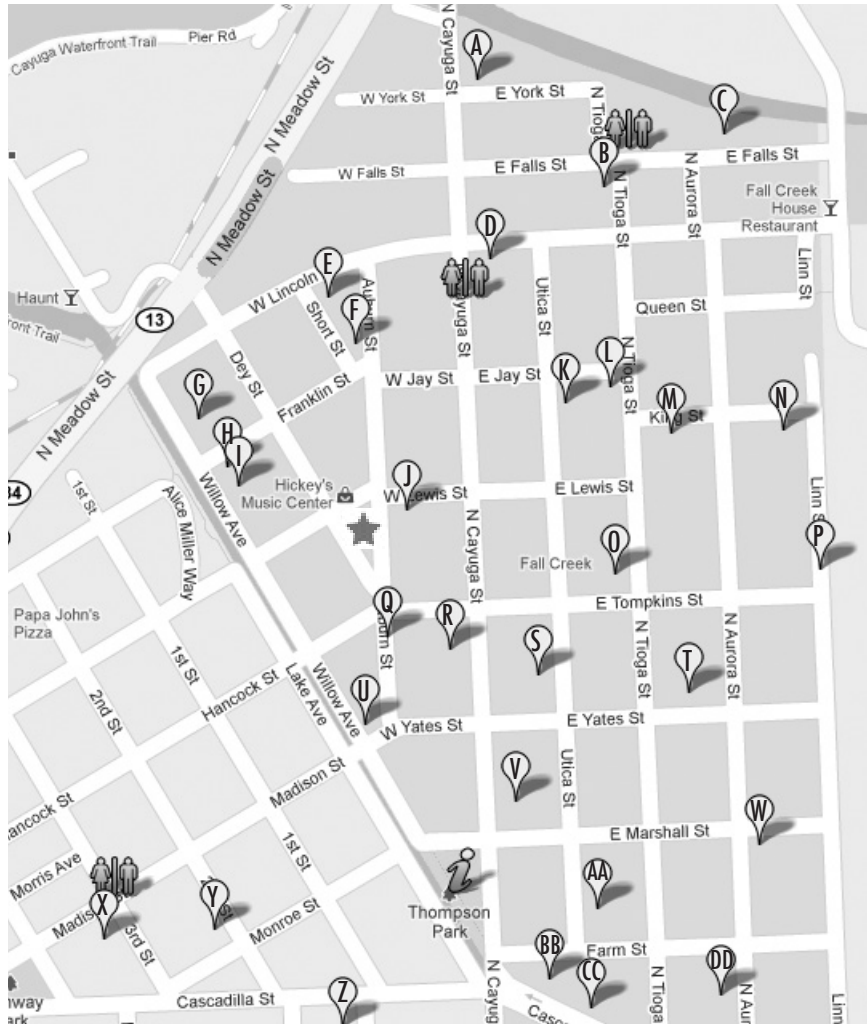
Will Fudeman, Susan Lytle & the Ithaca Community Sing [2] are originals and songs to sing along.
